## AUDITORS' REPORT


To the Directors of:

The Association is a registered charity that solicits donations in Canada and applies them toward projects in Ethiopia.

## **1. Significant accounting policies**

- a) Revenue recognition  
Revenue is recorded on an accrual basis.
  
- b) Contractual obligations and contingencies  
The organization has entered into a partnership with the Anti-Malaria Association (AMA) to build "Pit Latrines" at two elementary schools in Ethiopia. As of December 31, 2002 the project was not complete. Upon completion of this contract, the organization will pay \$6,127 US to AMA.
